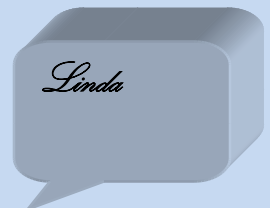
I have made my own websites, written content on them, and written for articles directories, blogs and have hundreds of articles online.

Chapter 2

The Bible is not just a book. It is the inspired Words of God. Read further please...

The Bible being the Word of God; (as it is now often called) recorded in manuscripts and authored by those who were scholars and those who believed in God. It is known throughout the world as the book that out sells any other book. History concludes that greater than 5 billion copies have been sold.

Annually, there are more than 100 million copies sold, and often referred to; as the Greatest Books on Earth.

When the Books were established: The Bible, the Word of God came into existence in the fifth century of the Christian era. The word Bible is used as the title of the Old and New Testaments. The name is derived from the Greek word for book (biblos).

These Books came into use in the following manner: In the synagogues there were priests who were in charge of the manuscripts and later in the churches and they referred to them as "the Books." Later in this history; the word book, or biblos, included the entire collection of books.

The Bible hence, is known as The Books. It is common knowledge that the original Books were written in Hebrew; with two known books, that of Daniel and Ezra in Biblical Aramaic, and the first translation was in Greek. There are many versions of the Bible now; some written using different English words, but with the same meaning.

The Christian Old Testament contains 24 books of the original Hebrew Bible. The second part of the bible is referred to as the New Testament which entails the birth of Jesus, His time on earth, the crucifixion, His resurrection, and His decent unto Heaven.

There are many skeptics within the world who want to degrade, declassify, and refute that there was an original Bible or Books that was written by men scholars, apostles, and inspired by God.

These are the same people who question the existence of God Himself. Those speculations have been reputed time and time again and this Book was written long ago.

The original Bible was written over a period of 1500 years, by 40 authors, and the Scriptures were made up of 66 books; 39 chapter in the Old Testament, and 27 in the New Testament.

There are many historians and archaeologists who have acknowledged studies cannot prove that the Bible is God's written word, but they can and do substantiate the Bible's historical accuracy.

The men who wrote it were the ones inspired by God and put it into words; God's Words.

Jewish archaeologist, Nelson Glueck has stated that categorically no one discovery has ever controverted a Biblical reference. They have confirmed that within the Book of Acts, known as the Gospel of Luke; there are consistent names and places i.e. cities, kings, and governmental figures in important Biblical places that existed during this time. This includes 32 countries, 49 plus cities, and eight plus islands; without any error.

*Some Bibles will give you this information at the front of the chapter for instance in the Book of Acts; it is titled: The Missionary Journeys, with an outline of the cities.

We again want to establish that faith is how we become rooted and grounded in the Word of God, and if you read the Word, God can and will manifest Himself to you through His Word.

Faith is the key to how anyone views the validity of

God's inspiring Word, Jesus' virgin birth, and death on the cross. It is with prayer and studies that anyone can come to believe if they keep searching and ask the Father for His tender mercy and guidance.

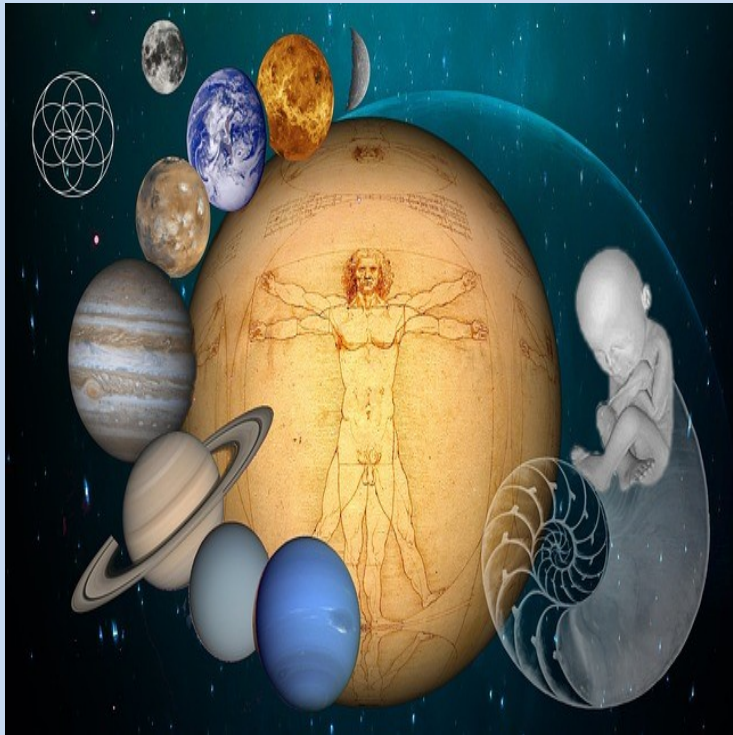
Real faith will help you believe what you cannot see, and often the part that you do not fully understand. But, you feel it, you will know it, and you will then live it.

In rural areas still today; homeowners can drill into the ground, sometimes it is very deep, and have what is called a private well.

Interesting Point of Freezing and Boiling

Chapter 5

There is not room here to write all of the true miracles of how the human is made. So you will find only highlights of part of the human existence. Yes, you are familiar with what is written here, but the magnitude of it is often left to speculation. From conception to birth; how you became a living soul is so miraculous.

This subject is known to be touchy to those who do not believe. It appears they want to get angry and prove something which in all practical senses; they cannot prove. They simply believe what other humans, who are educated, but lacking divine revelation has deemed truth. Some of it sounds reasonable; but the cosmic explosion is so much a misconception.

Christians on the other hand, believe the history of the Bible written by educated men of the time; who scribed on parchment paper; what they saw and heard.

They did not simply write down false letters or statues which were not authentic.

Moses was the author of Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers and Deuteronomy of the Old Testament. Genesis gives the creation of the Heavens and Earth and the creation of man in the first chapter.

“And God said; let us make man in our image, after our likeness, and let them have dominion over the earth...Genesis 1: 26a, and then in...

Chapter 2 Moses continues in verse 7-“***And the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.***”

If you believe nothing else ever in your life, think about the aforementioned scriptures. These writings of Moses are back up by several authorities to include; Titus Flavius Josephus, who was a first-century Romano-Jewish scholar.

Titus Flavius Josephus was a first-century Romano-Jewish scholar, historian and hagiographer. His work entails chapter after chapter and insights into the first century Judaism and the background of early Christianity. He writes about the creation of the earth, as well and follows the same written words of Moses with some, but very little deviation.

This is Josephus' translation of Moses writings:

"Moreover, Moses, after the seventh day was over begins to talk philosophically, and concerning the formation of man, says thus; That God took dust from the ground, and formed man, and inserted in him a spirit and a soul. The man was called Adam, which in the Hebrew tongue signifies that of red, because he was formed out of red earth, compounded together; of that kind is virgin and true earth. "

This writing confirms Moses writing, with practically the same verbiage.

Man was given a living soul as well as a helpmate formed from a rib of the man called Adam.

Let me ask again; is there doubt that the earth and human life came into existence by cosmic explosion?

Please read on....

I want to break this down a little further into the body anatomy, and some of what is so breath taking when you realize the magnitude of how the human body is aligned to survive.

The human body has 12 systems that make up the anatomy. Each system has a performance that must take place to keep the body alive. These systems are named the following:

- Skeletal
- Muscular
- Cardiovascular
- Endocrine
- Nervous
- Respirator

- Immune/Lymphatic
- Urinary
- Female Reproductive
- Male Reproductive
- Integumentary

All of the above systems work together simultaneously for the human being to function in a healthy manner and live life as it should be lived.

Without getting into each of these as most are familiar. But, if you were to study each of these systems, your eyes would be more open to the fact that only our

God could make a body that functions like the human body. Your entire body contains all of the necessary quantities for living; if something goes out, you get sick.

The Cardiovascular System

To have a healthy heart our veins must carry about 5 liters of blood to, through and from the heart to the rest of the body. This is so that we receive oxygen, nutrients, hormones, and cellular waste products flow throughout the body.

Cellular Waste Products Definition:

Cellular Waste Products are formed as a by-product of cellular respiration, a series of processes and reactions that generate energy for the cell.

The heart is only the size of a human fist; yet it is classified as the body's hardest working organ. If it doesn't beat; you do not live.

The blood could not be carried throughout the body without the blood vessels and/or arteries which are a necessary part of the circular system. The most important jugular veins are located on each side of the lower neck. The external carotid artery, the left external jugular vein, the left internal vein, and the very important and crucial vertebral artery are just in the right location for our body's circulation system.

Each part of the body, head, skull, eyes, face, nose, heart, lungs, kidneys, arms, hands, lower torso; legs and feet all have certain specifically named arteries and veins that carry blood, nutrients and take the waste through and out. The arm and hand alone have 18 of these veins and arteries.

There is so much more to the cardiovascular system than we can discuss here.

The Endocrine System

This is the system which includes the glands of the body and the hormones produced by these glands. The nervous system controls and sends the stimulation to the glands as well as the chemical receptors in the blood and hormones; produced by the glands. While regulating the functions of organs in the body; these organs assist in the maintaining the body's homeostasis.

The Nervous System

The nervous system is another crucial and very sensitive part of our body which consists of the brain, spinal cord, sensory organs; the nerves that connects the organs with the rest of the body. This is where our Central Nervous System is contained, and the brain and spinal cord forms this control center of the body and is where the information is analyzed and decisions are made.

It is common knowledge that your spinal cord is a critical link and necessary link between the brain and most of the body.

If this mass of nervous tissue is severed; it can cause paralysis or sudden death.

The Reproductive System

As we discuss the uniqueness of some of our vital systems of the human body; let's not forget about the reproductive system.

It is hard for those who do not believe in God to render any significance to the Christian beliefs that life begins at conception. It is more of a convenience for humans not to believe the aforementioned so that their frailty of living a life of questionable behaviors is hidden. Let me add; to the expense of an unborn child.

God created man first, and then He took Adam's rib, and thereby made woman to help replenish the earth. Genesis 2: 23-25.

A male or female alone cannot produce a zygote within the woman; which is one small cell embryo that grows into a fetus, and thereby a healthy baby.

The male's cell is 23 of the 46 chromosomes which are needed to assist a normal human life.

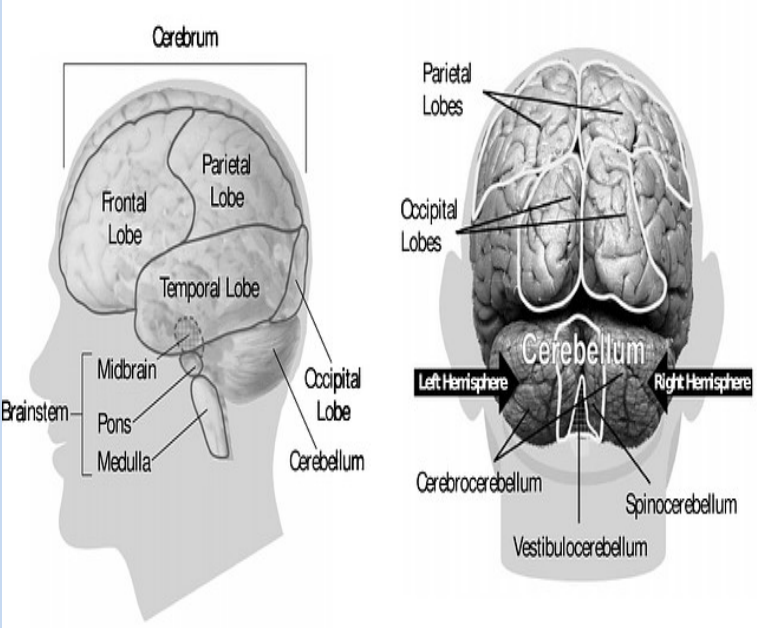
The female's reproductive cell's (ovum) contribution is the other 23 chromosomes. More or less would not produce the necessary components to form an embryo to grow and live human life.

Did you know that within the development of the embryo the heart beats after about 25 days? The other organs are developed, and the brain waves can be monitored after 40 days approximately. The heart starts beating about the fifth week. From there the little miracle matures in so many little and crucial ways to form a little human being.

The embryo, fetus, baby and all of this process is called 'life's greatest miracle.' It is that without one doubt. Why would anyone argue?

Chapter 6

The brain has so many little necessary components and is made up of the:

- Left Hemisphere -Surface; and the
- Right Hemisphere - Interior

There is within these hemispheres all of the necessary elements necessary to coordinate the body with the mind, the eyes, the spinal cord, the hearing, speech, muscle control, language and more.

Within the cerebellum portion of the brain; the motor functions which are habit to us; exist. These are known as balance and coordination, walking, routine hand and arm motion, eye movements, other motor senses like brushing our teeth, typing on the computer, walking, smiling, and more.
